

Club Project Options for 2026-27 Term

Sowing Seeds of Change: Leaders Advancing the UN Sustainable Development Goals

Club Project Option #1

Example focus: SDG 8 or SDG 10

Micro-impact project: Local business SDG commitment initiative

What they do: Engage local businesses and invite them to adopt one simple, visible action aligned with an SDG such as hiring practices, supporting women-owned suppliers, or community engagement. Provide participating businesses with an NFBPWC SDG commitment decal or window sticker to display publicly

Year-one outcome: number of businesses engaged, number of businesses committing to an action, number displaying the decal, and increased visibility of NFBPWC in the community leading to new member interest

Club Project Option #2

Example focus: SDG 5 – Gender Equality

Micro-impact project: Women-supporting-business directory

What they do: Identify and promote local businesses that actively support women through hiring, leadership, or community engagement and publish a simple directory shared locally and online

Year-one outcome: number of businesses listed, number of businesses engaged, community reach of the directory, and increased visibility and membership inquiries

Club Project Option #3

Example focus: SDG 4 or SDG 8

Micro-impact project: “Bring a woman with you” open event series

What they do: Host open events (physical or virtual) where every member brings a non-member guest, focused on practical topics such as career growth, business, or digital skills

Year-one outcome: number of events held, number of guests attending, conversion of guests to members, and overall membership growth

Club Project Option #4

Example focus: SDG 4 – Quality Education

Micro-impact project: Digital literacy access series

What they do: Host a monthly virtual session teaching basic digital skills, job search tools, and introductory AI tools. Open sessions to non-members and promote them publicly.

Year-one outcome: 10 to 12 sessions delivered, total number of participants tracked, repeat attendance, and number of participants who join NFBPWC after attending.

Club Project Option #5

Example focus: SDG 9 – Industry, Innovation & Infrastructure

Micro-impact project: Women’s innovation roundtable series

What they do: Host open quarterly roundtables where women can bring ideas, challenges, or early-stage concepts, with light facilitation and peer discussion

Year-one outcome: 4 roundtables hosted, total attendance including non-members, number of returning participants, and new members gained

Club Project Option #6

Example focus: SDG 8 – Decent Work & Economic Growth

Micro-impact project: Business visibility sessions

What they do: Host monthly sessions where women can present their business, services, or ideas in a supportive environment focused on visibility and connections

Year-one outcome: 8 to 10 sessions held, number of participants presenting, number of attendees, connections or collaborations reported, and new member conversions

Club Project Option #7

Example focus: SDG 8 – Decent Work & Economic Growth

Micro-impact project: Career support and networking sessions

What they do: Host open monthly sessions focused on resumes, LinkedIn profiles, interview preparation, and networking

Year-one outcome: 10 to 12 sessions held, number of women attending, repeat attendance, number reporting job interviews or opportunities, and new members gained

Club Project Option #8

Example focus: SDG 5 – Gender Equality

Micro-impact project: Women’s visibility initiative

What they do: Identify and promote women for speaking opportunities, panels, and local events, and create a simple speaker list to share with local organizations

Year-one outcome: number of women promoted, number of speaking or leadership opportunities secured, partnerships developed, increased visibility, and new members attracted

Club Project Option #9

Example focus: SDG 10 – Reduced Inequalities

Micro-impact project: Community connection sessions

What they do: Host small, open gatherings connecting women to local resources, opportunities, and networks, bringing in guest speakers from existing organizations

Year-one outcome: number of sessions held, number of attendees, number of external organizations engaged, number of referrals made, and new member growth

Club Project Option #10

Example focus: SDG 9 – Inclusive innovation at the community level

Micro-impact project: Community idea lab

What they do: Host a small series of open sessions where women identify a local issue and brainstorm practical solutions

Year-one outcome: 3 to 5 sessions held, number of participants, one defined issue identified, one small pilot action taken, and new members engaged.
